



## THE FROST WIND ENSEMBLE PRESENTS FLORIDA PREMIERE OF CHRISTOPHER ROUSE'S "WOLF ROUNDS"

Coral Gables, FL (April 2, 2007) – The University of Miami's Phillip and Patricia Frost School of Music will present the Florida premiere of *Wolf Rounds* by Pulitzer Prize winning composer Christopher Rouse performed by The Frost Wind Ensemble, Gary Green, Conductor, on **Tuesday, April 17, 2007 at 8 PM**. The evening's program also includes Paul Hindemith's *Symphony in B flat* and Andre Jolivet's *Second Concerto for Trumpet*, featuring Craig Morris as trumpet soloist. This performance follows the Frost Wind Ensemble's world premiere of *Wolf Rounds* at Carnegie Hall in New York City on March 29<sup>th</sup> to a sold out house.
